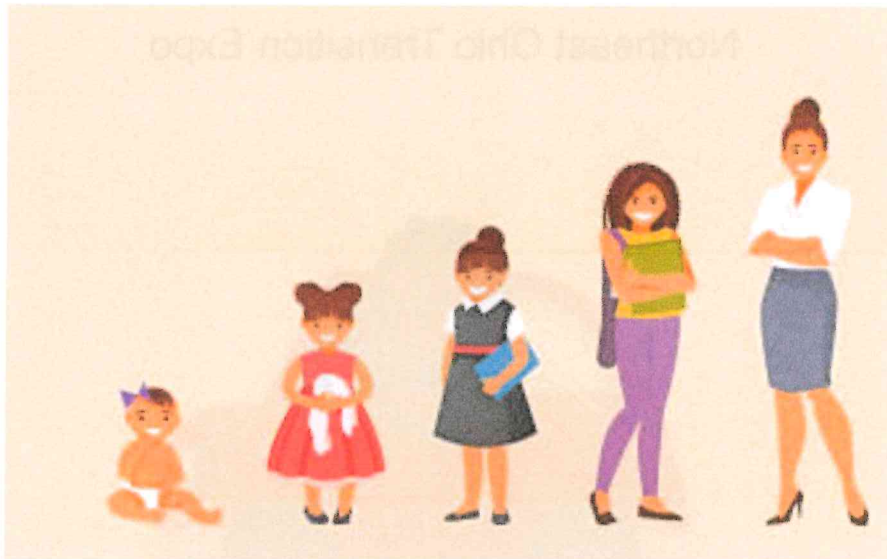
Northeast Ohio Transition Expo

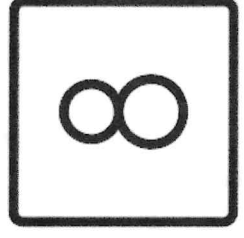
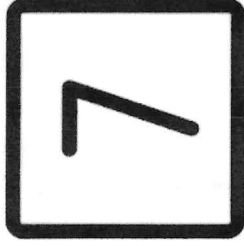
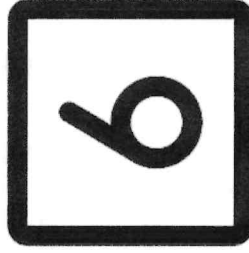
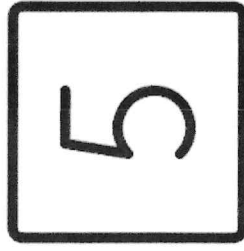
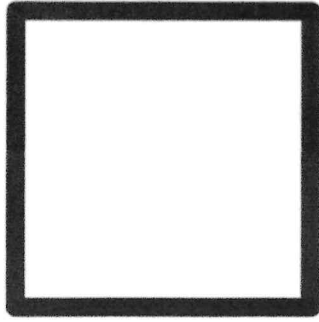
Transition Expo Activity Countdown
